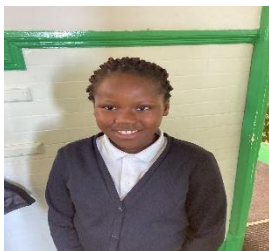
VE Day talk assembly
