Topic 1 -

Eco-Schools Topic	Marine
Aim Write a short explanation of what you hope to achieve.	- To promote an awareness in school about plastic pollution in our rivers and oceans. - To get children and staff talking about plastic pollution in our rivers and oceans.
Action(s) Add actions you are going to take/projects you will deliver to achieve your aim. Include delivery dates to set yourself a timeline.	By summer 2025 - create 2 murals for the KS2 and KS1 buildings to raise awareness of plastic pollution. -Work with the art club about delivering these. - Plastic themed images. - Eco warriors wanted sea turtle theme for KS2 and whale focus for KS1. Speak with year 4 and other year groups going on external visits, to take part in marine habitat cleans. (river bank and beach) -Use school litter pickers to help dispose of waste.
Informing & Involving Explain how you are going to advertise your activities and involve your school community in them.	- Link with headteacher and talk assemblies - Post final predict on school website. - Take photographs and post on website. - Inform others of finding from beach and river clean.
Monitoring & Evaluation Consider how you will monitor the impacts of your projects and evaluate their success.	- Check in with art club regularly to look at progress. - Ask for phot evidence of river/beach cleans. - have some pupil voice and ask if they are now aware of issues raised.

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Topic 2

Eco-Schools Topic	Litter
Aim	To reduce litter in the school grounds and on the school field and local area.
Action(s)	Throughout 2025 - Eco warriors to litter pick based on rota system. - Have conversations with SLT and business manager to see if more bins could be added to the grounds. - Look at recycling in school.
Informing & Involving	- Eco warriors to make posters about rubbish in school informing others to use bins. - Talk assembly linked to recycling and litter.
Monitoring & Evaluation	- Asses litter on playground at a starting point and assess a few weeks/months later after actions have been put into place.

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Topic 3

Eco-Schools Topic	Biodiversity
Aim	To help local wildlife such as insects, hedgehogs, birds in the school grounds.
Action(s)	By Summer 2025- -To add bug hotels to the school garden. -To maintain and add to the pollinator highway. -To create a mini pond to attract aquatic wildlife. -To set up bird houses and bat boxes to encourage other wildlife.
Informing & Involving	-to share news in assemblies and the website. -Potentially start an eco newsletter. -Create a 'spotted this year board' to go near the garden.
Monitoring & Evaluation	We will try and gain photo evidence of the biodiversity of the school garden and share these with the wider school and in assemblies and through the website.
